**Please notice the following special rules that are in effect during final exam week:**

- Thursday, May 19 is the last day to check senior attendance.
- Teachers are not to encourage their students to go home or to not come to school on exam days.
- On Tuesday and Wednesday, students will be allowed to check out **after the lunch period** with a parent note. On Thursday, students may check out after the 7<sup>th</sup> period exam with a parent note. They must have a separate note each day. Students will present the note to their teacher at the end of the lunch period and be permitted to leave after the dismissal bell for that period. **Students that check out must bring a parent note and sign out in the teacher's classroom before leaving campus each day.** Teachers are to escort any remaining students to the library. Teachers need to be available to students for assistance during the review periods each day.

- **ABSENCES DURING EXAM WEEK:** No student should be allowed to take an exam at any other time than when scheduled unless approved by administration. Any exception must be requested in writing by the parent and must be submitted to administration prior to Monday, May 16. Permission from an administrator is necessary for students to make up a missed exam! If a student is ill, he/she should go to a doctor. The doctor's note should be submitted to the administrator when seeking approval for a make-up exam.
- All classes on **Thursday, May 19** and **Friday, May 20** will **review** for semester exams. New material may not be taught and tests may not be administered on these days.
- **Parents may not check out students during examination periods** except in cases of extreme emergency as determined by an administrator. **Students will not be allowed to leave class until the end of the exam period.**
- Students may not enter an exam more than **10 minutes late**. Tardy students will be required to take a make-up exam.
- **All classes** are expected to administer a semester exam at the designated date and time. Exceptions may be made for seniors and classes such as athletics, but they must meet and do something productive/graded. Exams will be worth **20%** of the final semester grade for all courses.
- **Students must not visit other schools** while they are in session. Such an incident could put future flexible scheduling at jeopardy.
- **All students must have turned in their assigned textbook to the teacher before taking the semester exam in that subject.**
