COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to provide students with assistance geared to their specific needs for the upcoming Alabama High School Graduation Exam. Topics covered in class will be in the following subject areas: English, math, reading, history, and science.

COURSE GOAL: Student success on the AHSGE!!! (Of the seniors who took the AHSGE course last year, 98% passed.) We want you to pass the AHSGE, but you must want to pass it also!!! HAVE A POSITIVE ATTITUDE!

COURSE OBJECTIVES: All Alabama High School Graduation Exam Objectives for the five subject areas will be covered in this course (Objectives covered during each class period may differ according to the subject areas needed by each individual student.)

GRADING PROCEDURES: Grades for this class will be based on chapter and practice tests, quizzes, class work, presentation/project, and homework. Grades will be determined using a points system which will constitute the following percentages of a student's final grade:

Homework/class work	50%
Quizzes	30%
Tests	20%

FINAL GRADE: The student's final grade will fall within the following distribution:

D	60-69%
F	below 60%
